Paddle Safe-Paddle Smart Canoe & Kayak Workshop

The American Canoeing Association (ACA) and the American Association for Physical Activity and Recreation (AAPAR) have partnered to develop a curriculum and certification program in paddling sports (canoeing and kayaking). Persons successfully completing the workshop will be certified that they have demonstrated the knowledge and skills to teach the curriculum.
